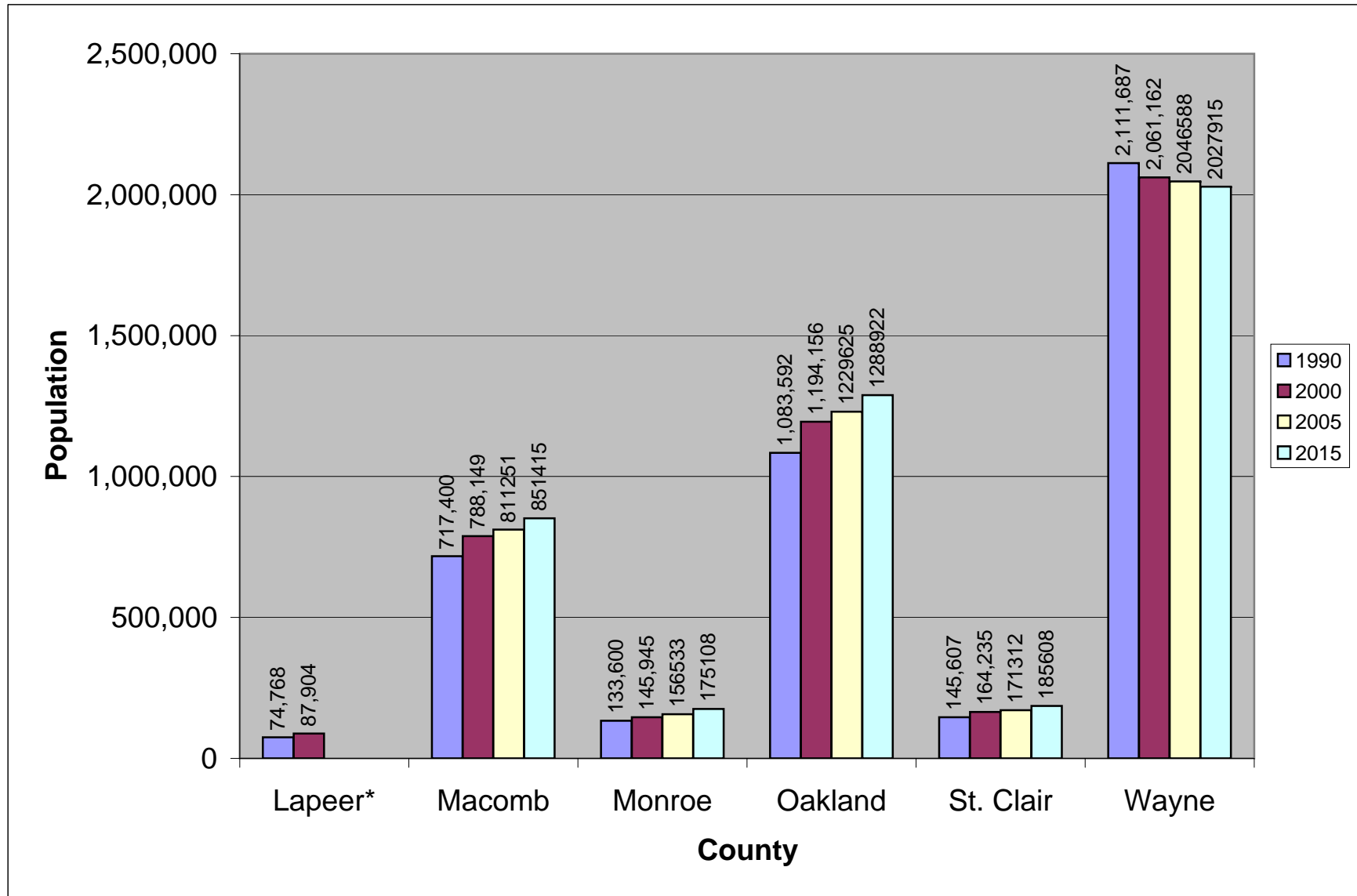
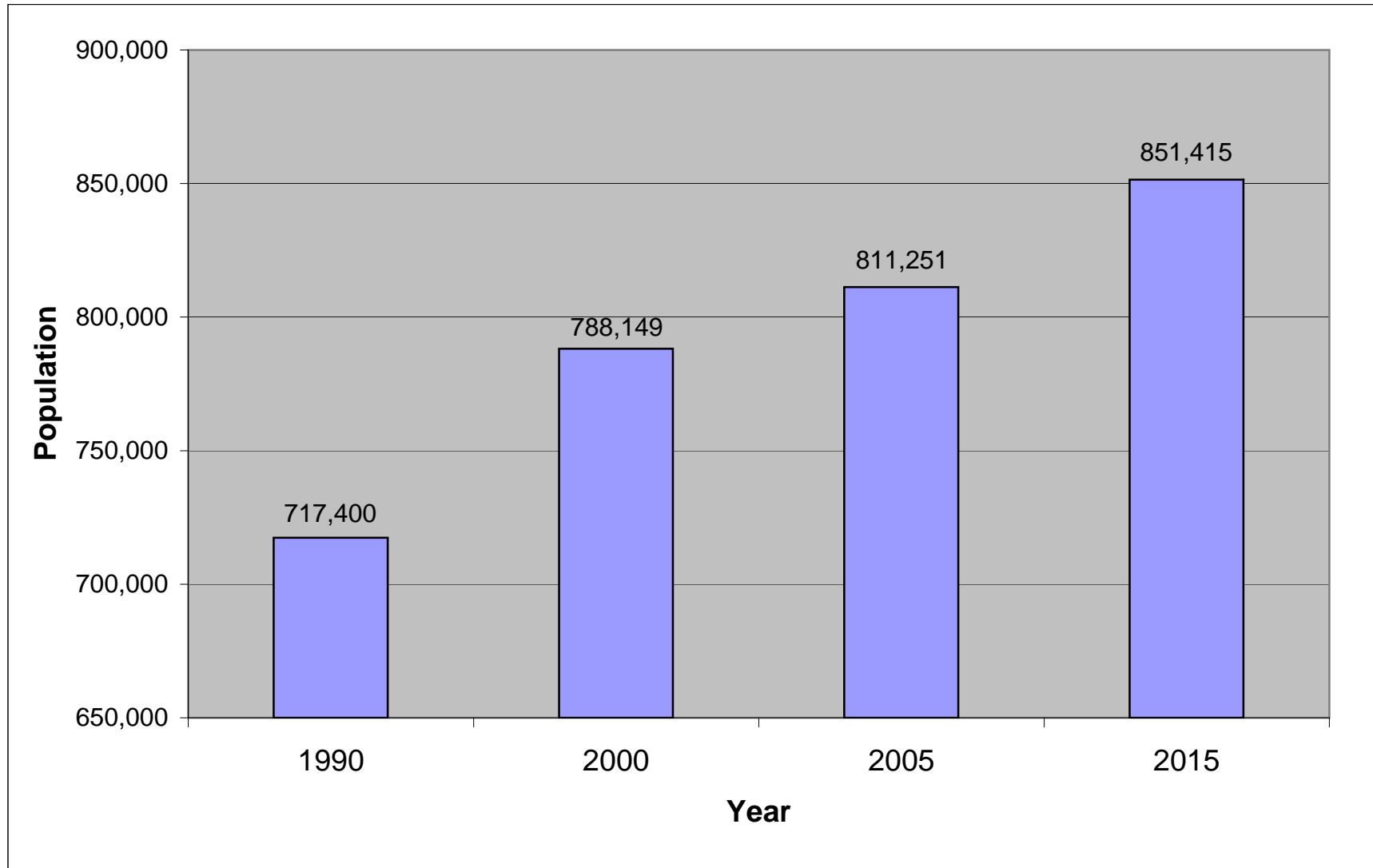


ARCHDIOCESE OF DETROIT

 1990 - 2015



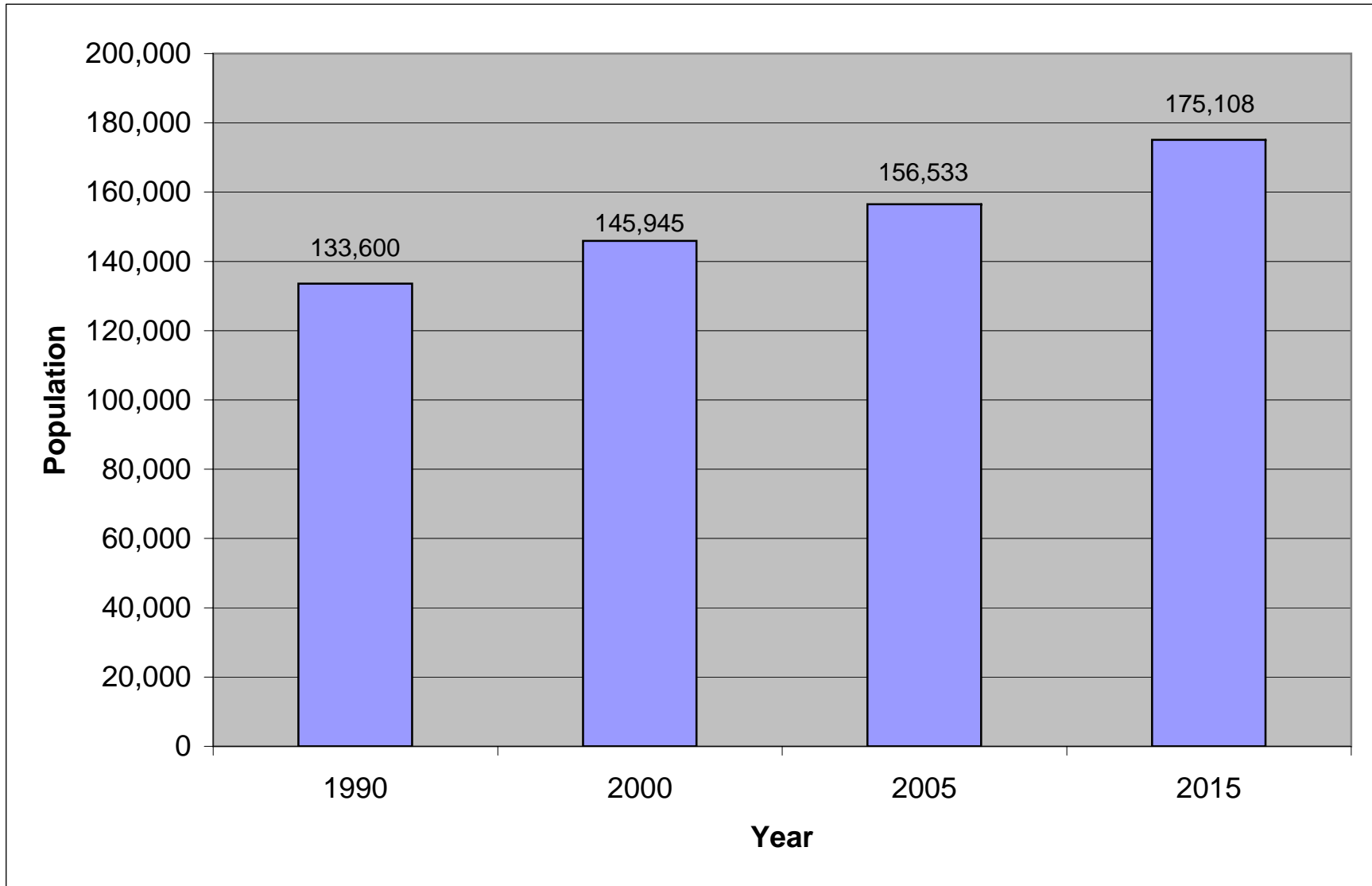

1990 to 2015 - 19% Increase



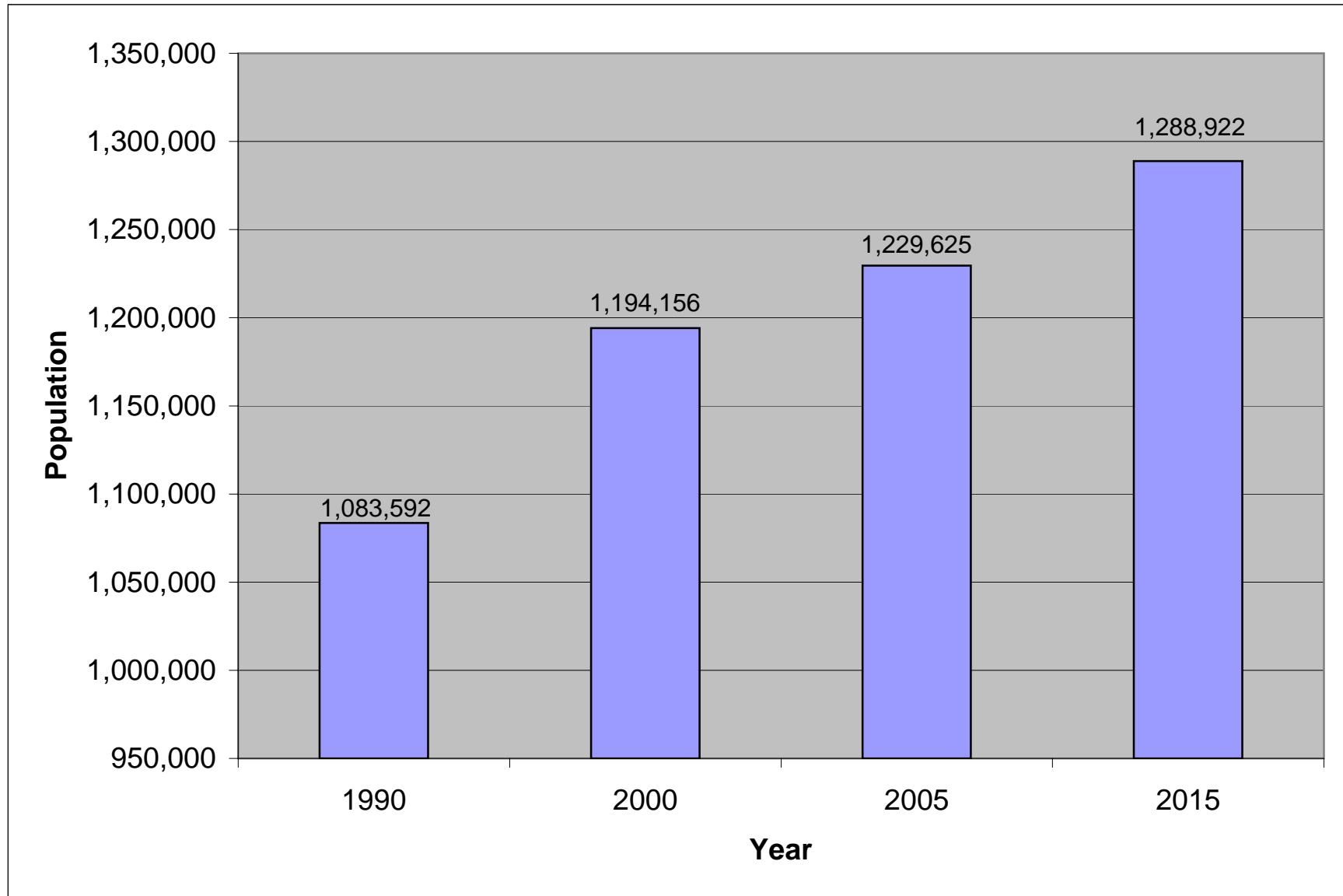
Note: This graph shows 19% population increase in Macomb County between 1990 and 2015.

1990 to 2015 - 31% Increase



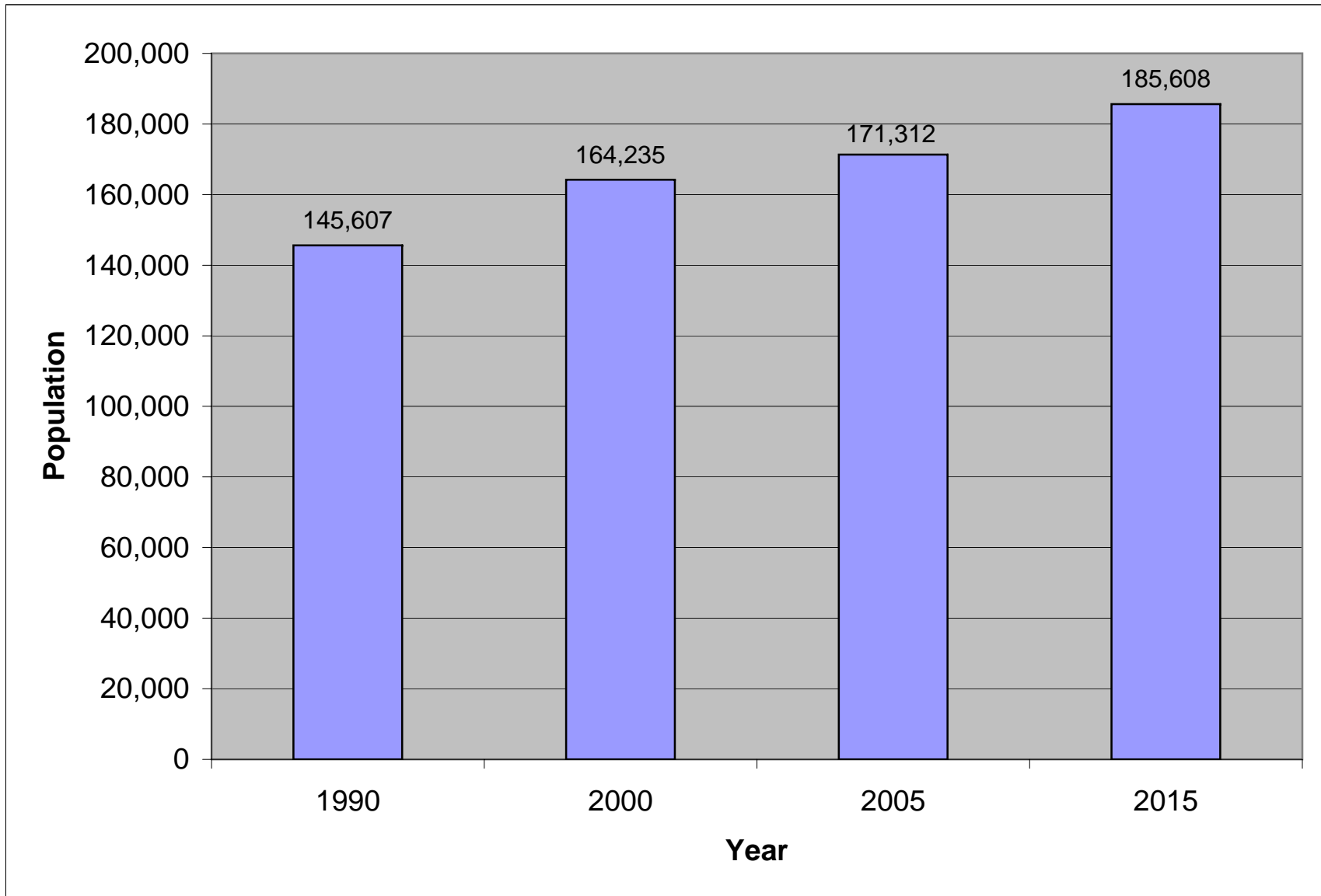
Note: This graph shows 31% population increase in Monroe County between 1990 and 2015.

1990 to 2015 - 19% Increase



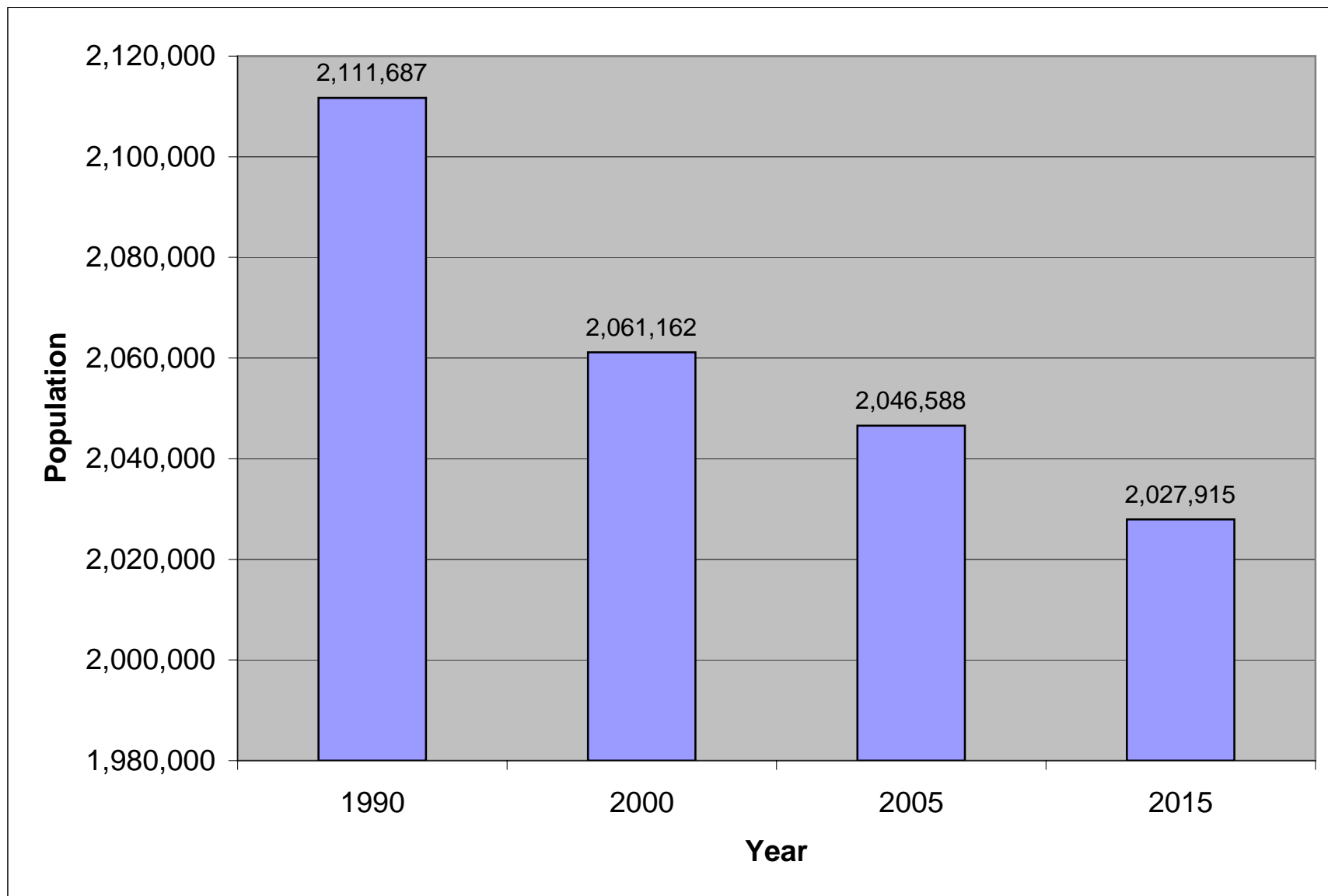
Note: This graph shows 19% population increase in Oakland County between 1990 and 2015.
